

MILITARY FAMILY ASSISTANCE SCHOLARSHIP Active Duty Military, Full Time Guard or Reserves and Military Retirees

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- (1) For family members of active duty personnel, full time Guard or Reserves, and Military Retirees.
- (2) Enrolled at Butler Community College in at least one credit hour.
- (3) There is a lifetime limit of 12 credit hours per student. If a student uses them in more than one semester, a scholarship application must be completed for each semester for the student to be considered.
- (4) The MFAS can **NOT** be used with veterans educational benefits except for CH 35, or third party payment programs or scholarships that pay for tuition costs such as MyCAA, Athletic, and Activity Scholarships etc.
- (5) EXCEPTION: Current high school students do NOT have to provide high school transcript for this award; Code 4538.

REFUND POLICY:
